

Support for All Students

In addition to classroom instruction, Carlton provides many opportunities for students to be successful with math.

Video Lessons

Carlton teachers have created video lessons specifically for Carlton students. These can be used in a variety of ways: catch up on missed classes, review before assessments, preview upcoming lessons, or complete a course on their own.

Math Tutor

Carlton hires a senior student to work as a math tutor after school. This is a free opportunity for students to get additional one on one help.

In grade 11 or 12, students can apply to be the math tutor, which is a paid position.

Extra Help


Carlton Math teachers are available for extra help before school, at lunch, and after school.

Want a Challenge With Math?

- Carlton participates in the Saskatchewan Math Challenge each year. In 2013 our team placed second in the province.
- Carlton provides the opportunity for students to write the University of Waterloo International Math Competition exams. In 2014 a group of grade 10 students placed first in our zone in the team category.

What Does Carlton Offer?

- We have removed time from the picture.
 Classes may be completed in less than a semester, or over more than one.
- Students can use video lessons to complete courses on their own. They would practice the outcomes on their own and then write exams with a teacher.
- Grade 9 students who are self motivated, have time outside of class to work on math, and can easily complete Math 9 in one semester.
- Math Prep 9: This yearlong program helps fill in gaps in prior knowledge. With this extra help, many students are then able to move onto one of our yearlong grade 10 classes.
- Both Math 10 classes have yearlong options. This allows students who need extra time to be successful in achieving a regular math credit.
