

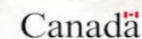


Carlton Pantry
