

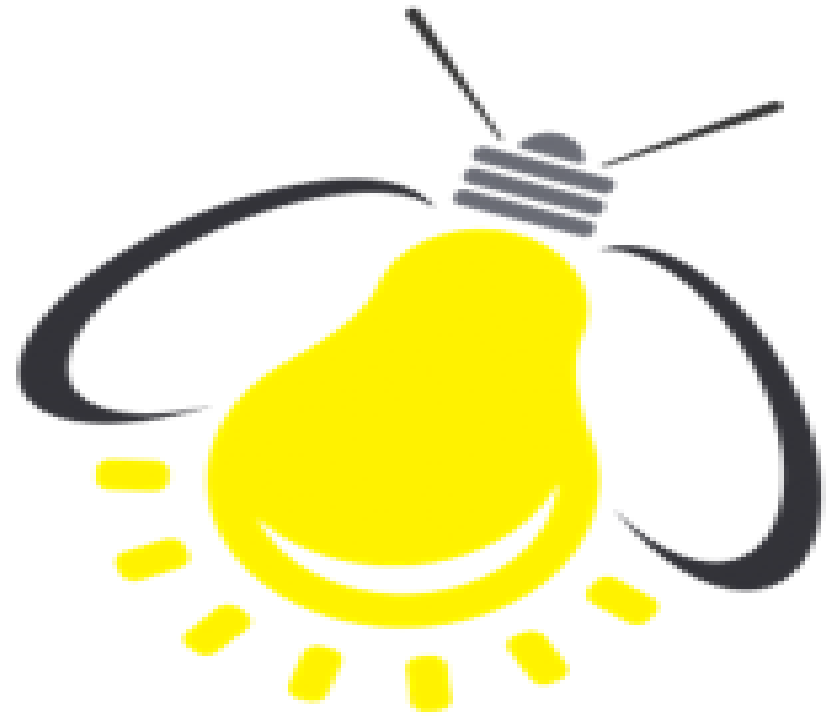
**The music room (Y101) is

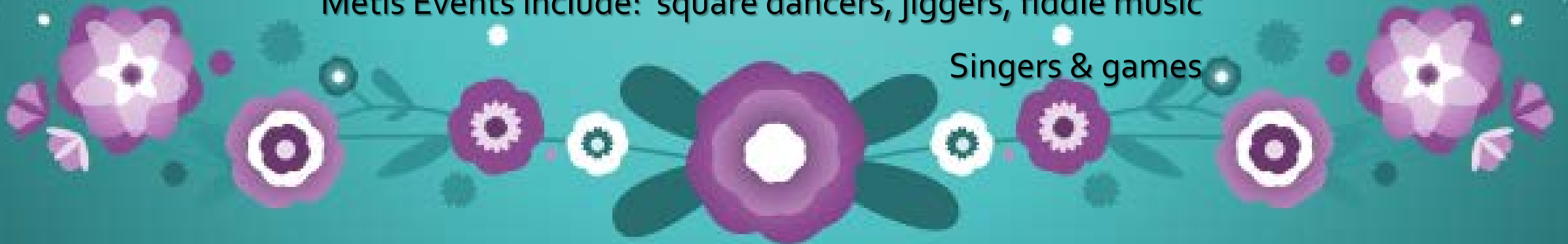

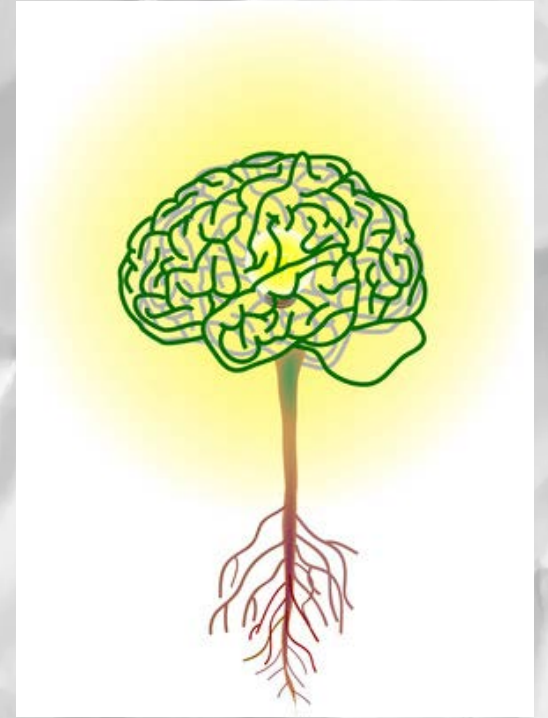
