

#### WorkSafe Saskatchewan Youth Video Contest 2022

WorkSafe Saskatchewan invites Saskatchewan students in grades 9 to 12 to create a two-minute video demonstrating workplace safety. The contest awards student and school cash prizes for the top three videos:

- 1st place \$1,000 (student/team) and \$1,500 (school);
- 2nd place \$750 (student/team) and \$1,000 (school); and,
