



Subject Line

Your subject line should be a short summary of your email (2-6 words).

Examples:

"Missing Assignments" "Technical Difficulties" "Late Work"



Say Hello

Just like you would in person, say "Hello" first.

Examples:

"Hi [Name]." "Good morning, Mrs. Gracey," "Greetings!"



To: myteacher@myschool.org Subject: Missing Assignment

Good Morning,

I am emailing you because I have already turned in my book report. However, it still shows that I am missing the assignment in the grade book. Can you tell me if you have received it?

Thank you for checking on this.

Why Are You Emailing?

Tell the teacher why you are emailing them. Include any relevant details.

Examples:

"I am emailing because..."
"I can't find..."
"Can you please help me with..."





End Your Email

Close your email with a simple goodbye.

Examples:

Thank you for your help."
Have a nice day.
"See you in class."

Include Your Name

Names are important, including yours! Let's use it.

After ending your email, do not forget to sign your name.



Agriculture / Rural Community Award - 2022

The District 32 Agriculture, Development and Diversification

Board (ADD Board) is offering a \$1,000 award to a Grade 12 student graduating in 2022. Students must be pursuing postsecondary education (university or technical) that will serve a rural agricultural community. Applicants must reside within one of the Rural Municipalities

(RM's) that are members of the ADD Board. This includes farm/acreage/town/cities within the RM of Prince Albert, RM of Buckland, RM of Garden River, RM of Paddockwood, RM of Duck Lake, RM of Kinistino, RM of Birch Hills, RM of St. Louis and RM of Invergordon. Students are asked to prepare a submission that addresses the following theme: "How will your post-secondary education make
