# HOW TO EMAIL A TEACHER

## Subject Line

Your subject line should be a short summary of your email (2-6 words).

Examples:

"Missing Assignments"  
"Technical Difficulties"  
"Late Work"

## Say Hello

Just like you would in person, say "Hello" first.

Examples:

"Hi [Name]."  
"Good morning, Mrs. Gracey,"  
"Greetings!"

Subject: Missing Assignment

Good Morning,

I am emailing you because I have already turned in my book report. However, it still shows that I am missing the assignment in the grade book. Can you tell me if you have received it?

Thank you for checking on this.

## Why Are You Emailing?

Tell the teacher why you are emailing them. Include any relevant details.

Examples:

"I am emailing because..."  
"I can't find..."  
"Can you please help me with..."

## End Your Email

Close your email with a simple goodbye.

Examples:

"Thank you for your help."  
"Have a nice day."  
"See you in class."

## Include Your Name

Names are important, including yours!  
Let's use it.

After ending your email, do not forget to sign your name.

## Ron Gunville Memorial Scholarship - \$1000

### Guiding Principles:

In conjunction with the Ron Gunville Memorial Tournament, the intent is that this scholarship will capture the soul and spirit of who Ron was; an amazing husband, father, friend, son, sibling and member of the hockey community. He had a passion for sports and working with the youth, especially at risk and marginalized youth. Ron had a positive attitude, competitive nature, he valued hard work and respected athletes and youth who demonstrated a high level of competitiveness and character. Sadly, Ron lost his courageous battle with cancer in December of 2018. This scholarship will capture the essence of who Ron was.

### Criteria:

The recipient of this scholarship will:

1. Be a graduate of Prince Albert Minor Hockey (PAMHA) or have been registered with PAMHA in the last 5 years. Provide a letter of confirmation from PAMH.
2. Grade 12 graduate or graduating in the current year.
3. Provide proof of enrollment in a post - secondary education with studies focused on Education, Human Justice, Health Sciences, Corrections or any program with a focus on working with youth.
4. 500 word essay or 2 minute video?? outlining the reason(s) to be considered/selected for the scholarship.
5. Two letters of reference from non-family members, coach or teacher for example, that indicate the applicant's passion for sport, integrity and admirable work ethic.
6. Provide a letter of proof from PAMHA confirming registration in the past 5 years.

### Application Process:

1. Applications open 7:00 am July 1 – September 15 11:59 pm.
2. All applications inclusive of all criteria to be submitted via email to [squnville1@sasktel.net](mailto:squnville1@sasktel.net) and [shawnpheuef@hotmail.com](mailto:shawnpheuef@hotmail.com)
3. Applications will be reviewed and scored by the selection committee.
4. The successful applicant will be notified via email.
5. Scholarship to be presented annually at the Ron Gunville Memorial Hockey Tournament.
