Graduating Grade 12 students from Saskatchewan Rivers, Prince Albert Roman Catholic School Division, Ecole Valois, and Adult 12 students from Saskatchewan Polytechnic Prince Albert Campus will have the opportunity to apply for two, one thousand dollar scholarships. Tillie and Joe Kawula Scholarship and Hershel Davidner Memorial Scholarhip

In 1982 a group of Prince Albert business people joined to raise money to create the Prince Albert and District Community Scholarship Fund. It began with the idea that students who **volunteer their time to make Prince Albert and community a better place should be rewarded for it.** That philosophy still remains and is the basis for the Tillie and Joe Kawula Memorial Scholarship and also the Hershel Davidner Memorial Scholarship. Academic standing is a factor however community involvement and volunteerism will carry the largest influence in determining recipients.

The Tillie and Joe Kawula Scholarship is named after Tillie Kawula and her husband Joe. Tillie was an outstanding community volunteer and Citizen of the Year. For over 25 years this scholarship has provided help to local high school graduates pursuing post—secondary education.

The Hershel Davidner Memorial Scholarship is named after the late Hershel Davidner who passed away in 2013. Davidner's Clothing and Western Wear Ltd family business has been owned and operated in Prince Albert for over 70 years. During those years, Mr. Davidner donated greatly to students through scholarships in post-secondary education.

These two scholarships will be awarded to students entering a post secondary school. Two \$1,000 awards will be given away annually. One application form will apply to both awards.

Please note the scholarship will primarily be awarded to students who are very involved in their community and their volunteerism. It is to recognize those students who exemplify leadership in their communities through their volunteerism.

These scholarships are open to Grade 12 graduates from Saskatchewan Rivers School Division, Prince Albert Roman Catholic School Division and SIAST Woodland Campus Grade 12 Academic Program.
