

# Grade 9 Programming and Supports

- Required Grade 9 Courses
  - Full Year Courses ELA 9, Math 9 (combined with Career Ed), Phys Ed 9 (combined with Health).
  - Quad Courses Social Studies 9, Science 9, Practical and Applied Arts 9, & Arts 9.
  - If you choose Band instead of Arts 9, it will run over the whole year and will be backed with another Quad course.
- Grade 9 Timetable
  - Some grade 9 classes run for one hour a day over the course of the whole year (Year Long Classes). These will be identified as period 1(P1), period 2(P2), P3, P4 and P5 on your timetable.
  - Other classes will run 2 hours a day for 10 weeks. These will be identified as QP1, QP2 and QP3 on your timetable.

- Sometime prior to August 19<sup>th</sup> you will receive a welcome letter and an updated copy of your timetable.
